From the Chair

Greetings to all.

The PRPA banner has been found. It turned up in the Gleneath club's storage room at the Kindersley Senior's Centre where they used to meet. Rella dropped it off at my place last week. I will see it gets to Swift Current in time for the AGM.

Back in November I had an interesting phone conversation with the nephew of W.C. Lovett, former PRPA chair and donator of the Lovett Showmanship trophy. I thought that the family of Bill Lovett would be interested to learn that the competition he donated a trophy for about 1970 is still going strong 50 some years later. I had no luck finding any Lovetts in the Medicine Hat online directory so I contacted the Medicine Hat archives. An employee there was most helpful and provided me with obituaries for Bill, his brother Walter, and his sister Emily.

Bill's obituary said he died in 2010 at age 84 and that he enjoyed spending time in his flower garden and the outdoors (it didn't mention photography). The obituaries also showed that neither Bill nor Walter had any children (which explained why there were no Lovetts left in the area) but Emily had two children. A recent newspaper clipping (also provided by the archivist) showed that her son, Gordon, a retired lawyer, was still living in the area. I cold called him, explained why I was calling, and had an interesting chat for 15-20 minutes. Gordon told me his mother (Emily) was also an amateur photographer and had been active in a Medicine Hat camera club.

My Christmas present for myself this year is a new home computer. My current mini-tower has only 4 gb of ram which won't handle the new photo editing programs. Rusty Morris from our photo club is building it for me—you will have met him if you were at the Hepburn Outing and you will find his winning images here and there in the Prairie Focus. He is putting in two 16 gb sticks of ram so I should be set. I also ordered a BenQ SW240 monitor to go with it. First thing when I get it up and running will be to buy the Luminar Neo program and Darlene Hildebrandt's course on how to use it. I'll let you know here how I like it.

Ever noticed how some movies could really benefit from expert consulting? One I watched recently on Netflix called "The Photograph" (2020) is a serious romantic drama about a Black woman photographer. One scene (at 18:50 minutes, in case you want to check it out) shows her setting up a darkroom in an old shack somewhere in south USA. She uses a red safe light and everything—just one little problem: it's broad daylight and there are 1 cm cracks between the boards.

Plans for the AGM on June 3 are taking shape. It will be a one day affair but the committee has packed a lot into that day. The spring competition deadline is fast approaching. The spring board meeting is planned for March 18th in Swift Current so you can send your print entries with your club rep. If not, you will have to mail them to the judging clubs. Remember, the prints must be **in the hands** of the judging clubs by April 1st, **NOT** postmarked by that date, and your membership in PRPA must be paid at that time.

Be sure to check the General Rules and Entry Instructions for Digital and Print Competitions and the criteria on the specific competition(s) that you are entering in the most recent PRPA Handbook which is available on the website in the Downloads Section.

We are working at updating the general rules for the photographs entered in competitions and bringing them up to date. With the inception of AI photo editing now at our fingertips I think it's time to visit possible changes. One competition in particular that Stan and I have discussed changing the description of is The Hand of Man. I've noticed time and again that some photographer's idea of what would fit in this category and what judges' think can be two very different things and unfortunately some very good photographs are overlooked.

The theme for the 2023 fall Russell Competition is ACTIVE/PASSIVE.




